



## Eastbound Ocean Boulevard Closure Postponed Rain-Delayed Project Scheduled to Start Jan. 11

January 4, 2013

Due to a forecast of rain, this weekend's planned closure of eastbound Ocean Boulevard between the Gerald Desmond Bridge and downtown Long Beach has been postponed.



The repaving project on eastbound Ocean blvd. between the Gerald Desmond Bridge and downtown Long Beach has been postponed several times due to adverse weather conditions, but is scheduled to go forward starting next weekend. The closures on January 11-14 will be the first of three weekend closures that are scheduled to continue January 18-21 and January 25-28. The weekend closures were selected to reduce the impact on commuter traffic. Work will generally start Fridays at 10 p.m. and finish by 5 a.m. Mondays. Throughout the closures, signs will guide motorists to detours.
