



Closures on Ocean Boulevard Planned Saturday, Feb. 9 Final phase of roadwork to be completed this weekend

Feb. 6, 2013

Ocean Boulevard between the Gerald Desmond Bridge and downtown Long Beach will be closed intermittently on Saturday, Feb. 9, as workers complete restriping of the new paved roadway.



- From 7 a.m. to noon, workers will close eastbound Ocean, and the on-ramp from Pico Avenue to the westbound Gerald Desmond Bridge.

- From noon to 5 p.m., workers will close westbound Ocean.

There will also be lane closures on the Desmond Bridge from 7 p.m. Saturday, Feb. 9 until 10 a.m. Sunday, Feb. 10, for an unrelated project. There will be at least one lane open at all times for through traffic.

Throughout the closures, signs will guide motorists to detours.

The Port of Long Beach is committed to keeping Harbor District roadways maintained in good condition and to minimizing the impacts of construction on motorists and businesses.
