Board to Consider Move to Temporary Headquarters Monday vote would move Port offices to 4801 Airport Plaza Dr.

November 2, 2012

The Board of Harbor Commissioners on Monday, November 5, will consider approving the purchase of an office building at 4801 Airport Plaza Dr., just east of the Long Beach Airport, as temporary headquarters for the Port of Long Beach administrative offices.

If the purchase is approved, the Port of Long Beach administrative staff, about 350 people, would move to the Airport Plaza Drive offices while a search continues for a permanent headquarters.

The current Port Administration building at 925 Harbor Plaza, built in 1959, is overcrowded and does not meet today's seismic standards. The Harbor Commission has placed a priority on moving the Port staff out of the current location because of overcrowding and safety concerns.

The Long Beach Board of Harbor Commissioners meets at the Port Administration Building, 925 Harbor Plaza, Long Beach, California, in the 6th Floor Board Room.
