



Closures Planned for Ocean Blvd. on Saturday, Feb. 16 Repaving project to be completed this weekend

Feb. 12, 2013

Ocean Boulevard between downtown Long Beach and the Gerald Desmond Bridge will be closed during the day Saturday, Feb. 16, for re-striping to complete a repaving project. Both directions will be closed, but at different times.



The closures are scheduled as follows:

- 7 a.m. to noon, workers will close eastbound Ocean, and the on-ramp from Pico Avenue to the westbound Gerald Desmond Bridge. The connection from eastbound Desmond Bridge to the northbound 710 Freeway will remain open.
- Noon to 5 p.m., workers will close westbound Ocean. The connection from the southbound 710 Freeway to westbound Desmond Bridge will be closed.
