



Anaheim St. to 710 Ramps, Harbor Ave. to Close West Long Beach roadwork to detour traffic April 25-28

On- and off-ramps connecting the 710 Freeway to westbound Anaheim Street in West Long Beach will be closed from 6 p.m. Friday, April 25, to 6 a.m. Monday, April 28, for a repaving project. Traffic will be detoured to Pacific Coast Highway.



Harbor Avenue will also be closed to north-south traffic at the intersection with West Anaheim Street, during the same time period, 6 p.m., April 25, to 6 a.m., April 28. The closure will temporarily block access from north of Anaheim.

Meanwhile, Anaheim will continue to have two lanes open in both directions in West Long Beach.

The work is part of an ongoing project to improve West Anaheim from the 710 Freeway to 9th Street at the western city limit.

An additional detour will be required the following weekend. The north half of the intersection of I Street and Anaheim will be closed from 6 p.m. May 2 through 6 a.m. May 5. That will close I Street access to Anaheim from the north side temporarily, and north-south traffic through Anaheim will be prohibited.

West Anaheim is undergoing a 14-month-long improvement that started in September 2013. The City of Long Beach Harbor Department is overseeing the work to improve the street, which is the northern boundary of the harbor district. In addition to roadway resurfacing, the project includes improvements for sidewalks, bus stops, median, and access for the

disabled and landscaping.
