



I Street to Close at W. Anaheim St. this Weekend

Anaheim still open in both directions during roadwork

Roadwork will close I Street at the intersection with Anaheim Street on the Long Beach-Wilmington border this weekend, from 6 p.m., May 9, through 6 a.m., May 12, for a repaving project. That will close I Street access to Anaheim from the north side temporarily, and north-south traffic through Anaheim will be prohibited.



Meanwhile, Anaheim will continue to have two lanes open in both directions in West Long Beach throughout the weekend.

The work is part of an ongoing project to improve West Anaheim from the 710 Freeway to 9th Street at the western city limit.

West Anaheim is undergoing a 14-month-long improvement that started in September 2013. The City of Long Beach Harbor Department is overseeing the work to improve the street, which is the northern boundary of the harbor district. In addition to roadway resurfacing, the project includes improvements for sidewalks, bus stops, median, and access for the disabled and landscaping.
