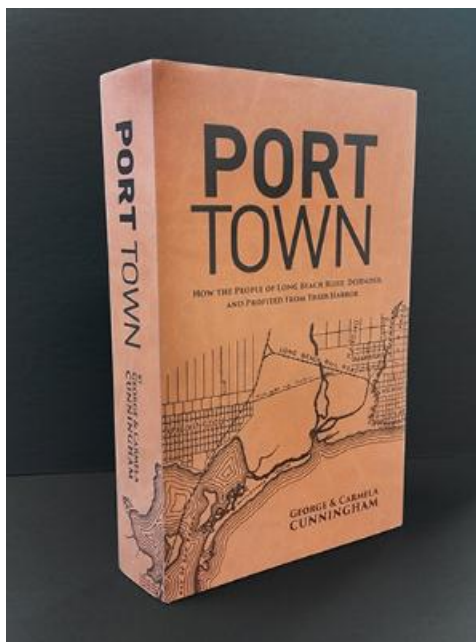
***Port Town* Available as E-Book and Paperback** **Vivid new history book tells the story of Long Beach and its Port**
