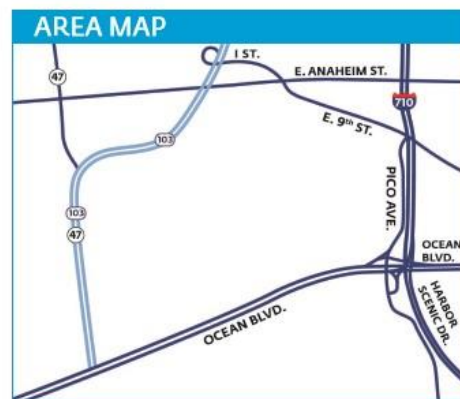
Nightly Closures Near Pico Avenue and Ocean Boulevard

Short-term closures to begin December 14

Dec. 9, 2015

As construction continues for the Gerald Desmond Bridge Replacement Project, temporary nightly road closures are necessary in the vicinity of Pico Avenue and Ocean Boulevard to facilitate installation of falsework over Pico Avenue and the on-ramp to westbound Ocean.

The Pico on-ramp to westbound Ocean will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday, December 14 through Thursday, December 24. Click [here](#) to download the closure flier with detours and maps.



The Pico underpass at Ocean and the westbound Ocean off-ramp to Pico will be closed nightly from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday, December 28 through Friday, January 8.



These closures will affect Port traffic headed to Terminal Island (Piers S-T and San Pedro, and Port traffic that uses Pico Avenue to travel between Piers A-D and Piers E-J).

Once the falsework is erected, motorists can expect to drive under tunnel-like structures in these areas. The falsework will be in place while the road deck is constructed.
