

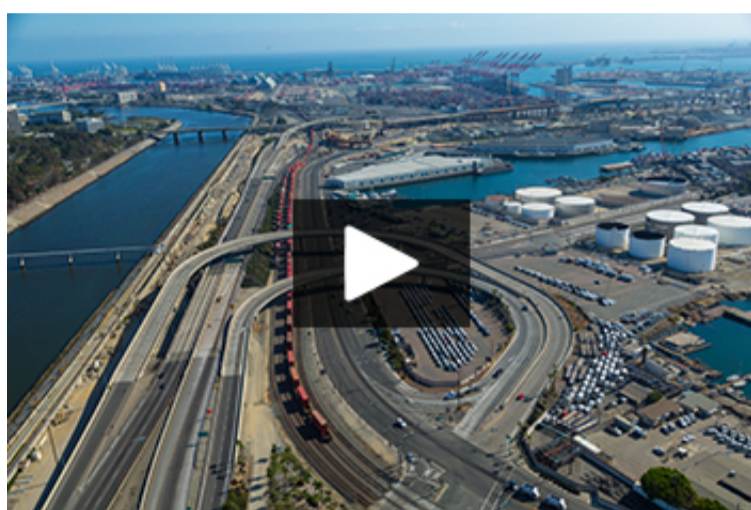


Season's Greetings from the Port

Rail Project Draft Study Released



Using on dock rail — delivering cargo containers directly to and from terminals by train — is an essential component of the Port of Long Beach's Green Port Policy and Clean Air Action Plan. Maximizing the use of rail brings key benefits — eliminating up to 750 truck trips for each full train, reducing diesel pollution, and increasing efficiency.

To that end, the Port is proposing to reconfigure, expand and enhance the existing Pier B rail facility located along Anaheim Street and the 710 Freeway to support more efficient use of “on-dock” rail at the Port’s shipping terminals. A Draft Environmental Impact Report has been released and public comments on the report are welcome through Feb. 13, 2017. Two public hearings are also scheduled in January.

Committed to Clean Air



The ports of Long Beach and Los Angeles are working on updating the [San Pedro Bay Ports Clean Air Action Plan](#) that has succeeded in dramatically reducing air pollution from port-related sources over the last decade. Since 2005, greenhouse gases have shrunk by an average of 12 percent and diesel particulate matter has been reduced by 84%.

The [new strategies proposed](#) by both Ports' governing boards are some of the boldest yet, and will require a significant amount of cooperation from the goods movement industry, regulatory agencies, and other stakeholders.
