### Board oversees intermodal cargo at ports of Long Beach, Los Angeles

The governing board of the Intermodal Container Transfer Facility Joint Powers Authority will meet at 6 p.m., Wednesday, Dec. 6, at the Port of Long Beach's Interim Administrative Offices, 4801 Airport Plaza Drive, Long Beach.

The ICTF serves to enhance the efficient flow of intermodal (truck and rail) cargo through the Port of Los Angeles and the Port of Long Beach. The 148-acre facility is located approximately 5 miles north of POLA and POLB, at the northern terminus of State Highway 103, and is operated by Union Pacific.

The ICTF JPA is a public entity created in 1983 to oversee the development and operation of the ICTF. The JPA is administered by a governing board that operates separately and apart from the cities of Long Beach and Los Angeles.
