**RUBIN TO MANAGE PORT FINANCES
Former L.A. Assistant Finance Director Joins Port**

Steven B. Rubin has been appointed the Port of Long Beach's managing director of finance and administration, one of the port's top four management positions. Rubin, formerly assistant director in the City of Los Angeles' office of finance, fills a newly created position established after the retirement last year of the port's assistant executive director, Paul E. Brown.

Like Brown, Rubin will oversee the port's divisions of administration, finance, information management and maintenance. He comes to the port with seven years of experience in public finance, and 10 years in the private sector.

Rubin was Los Angeles' assistant finance director for nearly a year and a half, managing more than 300 employees and a \$40 million operating budget, and the billing and collection of nearly \$2 billion of revenue annually. For six years, he was a member of Mayor Richard Riordan's senior staff, responsible for developing Los Angeles' annual \$4.2 billion capital and operating budget.

Rubin has an MBA in finance and marketing from UCLA, and bachelor degrees from the University of Pennsylvania, including a B.S. degree in international business from its Wharton School.
