Harbor Commission to Meet at Hudson School Sept. 24

Community board meeting part of Port outreach efforts

September 19, 2007

The Long Beach Board of Harbor Commissioners will move its weekly meeting on September 24, 2007, to the Elizabeth Hudson Elementary School auditorium, 2335 Webster Ave., on the city's Westside. The meeting will begin at 5:30 p.m.

"The Port is doing more than we've ever done in the past to reach out to the community, and the meeting at Hudson school is one of the ways we're doing that," said Commission President Mario Cordero. "We want to make it easier for Long Beach residents to learn about the Port, ask questions and participate."

Other Port community outreach engagement efforts include the Green Port Fest on October 13, the ongoing public boat tours, an educational program now being developed in cooperation with the Long Beach Unified School District, and the upcoming "Let's Talk Port" workshop series, which will visit different sections of the city to discuss Port operations and seek community feedback.

The Board's regular weekly meetings are at 1 p.m. on Mondays at the Port Administration Building at 925 Harbor Plaza. Commissioners voted unanimously on Monday, September 10 to move the September 24 meeting to Hudson School.
