New "Pulse of the Port" Airs on Web, Cable

The latest episode of Port of Long Beach's award-winning television program, "Pulse of the Port," is now available for viewing on the Port's web site, <http://polb.com/civica/Bulletin/www.polb.com/videos>, Youtube.com and on Long Beach Television Channel 8.

This month's "Pulse of the Port" takes a look at the grand opening of Fire Station #24, the proposed, \$750-million Middle Harbor Redevelopment Project, the Port's community tree-planting program and the 2008 "Green Flag" environmental awards.

"Pulse of the Port" began airing in September 2005 and, since then, has won awards from the American Association of Port Authorities and the California Association of Public Information Officials.
