



Near-dock Rail Yard Seeks Review of Modernization Project

The ICTF-JPA is welcoming public suggestions on the environmental impact report

The San Pedro Bay Ports and Union Pacific are seeking public review on an environmental impact report of a proposed modernization project at a rail yard near Long Beach that will reduce air emissions while improving efficiency of goods movement in the region.

The near-dock rail yard, the Intermodal Container Transfer Facility (ICTF), is owned by representatives from the ports of Long Beach and Los Angeles called the ICTF Joint Power Authority (ICTF-JPA). On January 9, 2009, ICTF-JPA began the environmental review process and welcomes suggestions from the public on what should be reviewed.
