### **Input Sought for Proposed Aggregate Terminal Port conducting study of 12.6-acre project on Pier B**

June 15, 2009

The Port will seek public input at meetings on June 18 and 25 on a proposal by Cembra Long Beach, LLC, to construct and operate a sand, gravel and granite aggregate facility on privately owned land in the Harbor District.

The vacant, 12.6-acre site is in the northeast part of the Harbor District, on Pier B Street next to the National Gypsum Co. facility.

The project is being proposed by a private company on private land. Because the site is in the Harbor District, the project is undergoing environmental review by the Port of Long Beach. As part of that process, the Port is holding public "scoping" meetings to gather input in advance of preparing the Environmental Impact Report (EIR).

The public input meetings will focus on issues to be addressed in the EIR.

The Port will host two public meetings:

- June 18, 2009, 6 p.m. at the Port Administration Building, 925 Harbor Plaza, Long Beach, 90802
- June 25, 2009, 6:30 p.m. at Long Beach City Council Chambers, 333 W. Ocean Blvd., Long Beach, 90802
