



Public Hearings Set for Proposed Terminal Port invites comment on Pier S at upcoming meetings

September 26, 2011

The Port of Long Beach invites the public to hearings on Wednesday, October 5, and Thursday, October 13, on draft environmental documents studying a proposal to develop a state-of-the-art, \$650 million container shipping terminal on Terminal Island. The development would showcase sustainable goods movement and generate up to 40,000 jobs in the region.



To offer the public an opportunity to comment in person on the documents, the Port is hosting two hearings:

- October 5, Long Beach City Council Chambers, 333 W. Ocean Blvd., Long Beach, 90802 (Parking structure entrance on the south side of Broadway between Chestnut and Cedar avenues.) Doors open at 6:30 p.m., presentation starts at 7 p.m.
- October 13, Cabrillo High School Auditorium, 2001 Santa Fe Ave., Long Beach, 90810. Doors open at 6:30 p.m., presentation starts at 7 p.m.

The proposed Pier S development on a vacant 160-acre parcel would utilize the latest technology and practices for reducing air pollution from cargo operations. In addition, the new terminal would help the Port to remain competitive and able to sustain additional jobs in the region.

The Port has released a draft environmental impact statement (DEIS) and supplemental environmental impact report (SEIR) analyzing the impacts of the proposed development, and the mitigation measures that would be used to address those impacts.
