



Roadwork to Improve Busy Port Intersection Harbor Scenic Drive, Harbor Plaza and northbound Queens Highway due for new pavement

September 29, 2011

Construction work to repair and repave the intersection of Harbor Scenic Drive, Harbor Plaza and northbound Queens Highway in the Port of Long Beach is set to begin Monday, October 3, 2011. The work is expected to take four to five months.

Once completed, the project will provide smoother driving for motorists at this busy intersection.

Construction at the site will likely result in some traffic delays. There will be lane closures, but roads will remain open during the work. There may be short periods during supply deliveries where there may be increased delays.

The Port of Long Beach, which is funding the project, is committed to keeping Harbor District roadways in good condition and to minimizing the impacts of construction on motorists.
