



Port to Prepare Impact Study on Grain Export Facility Public 'scoping' meeting August 24 to seek input

The Port of Long Beach has begun preparing an environmental impact report on a proposal to build a grain export facility at Pier T on Terminal Island. An initial public meeting, known as a "scoping" meeting, will be held August 24, at 6 p.m. at Long Beach City Hall to seek input on issues that should be addressed in the environmental report.
