As of Jan. 1, 2012, the last of the older trucks will be barred from service at the Port of Long Beach, thanks to the Port's groundbreaking Clean Trucks Program. Since late 2008, the innovative program has slashed truck-related air pollution by 90 percent by requiring that only newer trucks work at the Port. [Click here.](#)
