Port Completes Two Major Road Projects Reconstruction of two busy intersections improves traffic flow

The Port of Long Beach has completed two major street intersection-reconstruction projects in the Harbor District to improve the flow of both Port-related and commuter traffic.

The recently completed project at the intersection of West Anaheim Street and Santa Fe Avenue in West Long Beach upgraded the pavement with new, long-lasting concrete, correcting the problem of the rutted asphalt and potholes, which will reduce road repair and traffic interruptions for many years to come.

The Anaheim Street-Santa Fe Avenue project also upgraded subterranean water lines, sidewalks and street tree landscaping at the intersection. The intersection sits on a major route for port-related truck traffic and serves area motorists.

Meanwhile, the Port has also recently completed a repaving of the busy intersection of Harbor Scenic Drive and Harbor Plaza with concrete. This too will strengthen the roadway against ruts and potholes, and reduce the need for traffic-interrupting roadwork in the future. This intersection provides critical access for trucks and dockworkers to the Port's Piers G and J, and also to hospitality and tourism businesses on Pier H including the Queen Mary.

"We thank the residential and business communities for bearing with us during construction as we improved these two intersections," said Doug Thiessen, Managing Director of Engineering for the Port of Long Beach. "With the new, smoother, longer-lasting surfaces, traffic flow is much improved."
