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New Documents, Updated Schedule Released for Bridge Project

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The Port of Long Beach and the California Department of Transportation have released new documents related to the Request for Proposals (RFP) for the Gerald Desmond Bridge Replacement Project. The new documents include a Revised Procurement Schedule.

The Port and Caltrans in 2011 issued an RFP to the four eligible engineering and construction teams to design and build a new bridge to replace the existing 44-year-old span in the Port of Long Beach.
